Ancient wellness treatments in Kerala

The tropical province of Kerala, India, is the birthplace of Ayurveda, a 5,000-year-old wellness tradition based on the harmony of one's body, mind, and soul.





HOW TO EXPLORE KERALA

Palace, ramble through the green paddy fields of

Agentle breeze sweeps in from the Arabian Sea, causing the white linen curtains in my treatment room to billow ever so slightly. Save for the steady drip of herb-infused oil from a copper pot suspended above my head, it's all stillness and quiet here at Somatheeram Ayurvedic Beach Resort in Kovalam, Kerala India

Stretched out and face up on a hand-carved teak tabletop, wearing what can be best described as a minimalist loincloth, I dreamily submit to my first Ayurvedic experience.

Each drop of lukewarm oil onto my forehead (my eyes protected by a damp cloth) lulls me deeper and deeper into a state of sheer relaxation. Muscle tension dissipates. Worries flee. When my attendant first explained Shirodhara therapy, a form of Ayurveda, I thought I'd be unsettled by an oil-on-theforehead treatment. But not so: A welcome warmth spreads throughout my entire body.

Ayurveda, which is Sanskrit for "the science of life," is a holistic healing practice that began in India more than 5,000 years ago, long favored by everyday working folk as well as the royal families of the Maharajas. Kerala is the epicenter of Ayurvedic medicine, attracting legions of visitors who sign up for rejuvenation therapy, detoxification/body purification, stress management, weight loss, antiaging and beauty care programs, among others. Many health-minded visitors, like me, simply seek to reboot, while others look to Ayurvedic medicine to address concerns such as arthritis, heart disease, severe anxiety, acne and persistent insomnia.

Ayurvedic regimens, which last anywhere from a few days to a few weeks (though one-time treatments are available), begin with an assessment by a doctor trained in the science of Ayurveda. (There are plenty of Ayurvedic centers throughout Kerala.) The ultimate goal is to bring equilibrium to the body, mind, and spirit by balancing the three elemental energies: Vata (air/space), Pitta (fire/water), and Kapha (water/earth). This is achieved through various combinations of oils (mostly herb-infused), massages and dietary changes to rid the body of toxins.

My prescribed treatments – which one day includes a skin-softening buttermilk bath - take place each morning. Afterward, I'm free to wander the 15-acre grounds of Somatheeram (the world's first resortstyle Ayurvedic treatment center), lunch on vegetarian curry served atop plantain leaves, loll on a nearby beach, or (admittedly) grab a mid-day nap in my private bungalow. Late afternoons are sacrosanct: meditation, followed by outdoor yoga.

I awake on day three feeling energetic yet peaceful, my body free of tension - physical and emotional. I am greedy for more, so I opt for the much-talkedabout, four-handed Pizhichil hot-oil massage. Face down on the wood table this time. I feel the rhythmic. synchronized hand motions of two attendants as they massage heated herbal oil directly onto my shoulders, neck, and back. One attendant, Surej, assures me that the warm oil extracts will enhance blood circulation, relieve muscle pain - and equally important - "boost the spirit."

It certainly does: I return home on a Kerala high.







FLAVORS, AFLOAT: Tasting China's Eastern Coast

For intrepid travelers hoping to explore a small sampling of a very large region, sailing on the newly upgraded Crystal Symphony offers both easy passage and creature comforts.



Not that we didn't love being onboard; our Crystal voyage was the perfect mode of transport for tasting our way through China's diverse food culture. In addition to the remarkable pleasures of opening the curtains every morning to a new destination, the elegant ship also replicated the creature comforts of home—a sublime complement to long days spent exploring exotic locales.

We started in Hong Kong. Working our way down narrow, bustling Wellington Street, we sampled bowls of shrimp wonton noodle soup, a Cantonese specialty. Next, in the pretty port town of Xiamen, we dove into sweetened peanut soup and buns stuffed with chives and pork fat, and then wandered into a small shop where the proprietor made us cups of strong Pu'er, a fermented black tea.

Shanghai was a little different because I had a specific goal: I wanted to track down the legendary "Mr. Lu," a septuagenarian who was rumored to make some of the country's best scallion-pork pancakes from his back alley shop, located somewhere among the French Concession's winding streets. When we finally found him, we lined up for 45 minutes, eagerly watching the slow-moving Mr. Lu roll every pancake by hand and then gently place it inside an extremely hot oven. The pancakes were crispy and chewy, enlivened by savory pieces of pork and sharp scallions.

Each day, after exploring the monuments and laneways of multiple Chinese ports, I was thrilled to return to a glass of Champagne on deck as we set sail, watching the city lights disappear behind us as the sun dipped in the sky. We indulged in rich duck ragu and handmade pasta in the ship's restaurant, Prego, and tender fresh fish from its onboard Nobu-inspired Umi Uma & Sushi Bar. On days at sea, we relaxed in the spa's steam room and then set up camp in the elegant Palm Court, sipping cappuccinos and eating cookies while scanning the horizon for passing ships.









By the time we got to Beijing, you might expect me to tell you that I was kind of full. But that would be a lie. When we disembarked, I made a beeline to hand-pulled noodles and crispy-skinned Peking duck slowly roasted over datewood. I was happy to be onshore, once again focused on regional delicacies. I'll admit it was bittersweet to bid adieu to the Crystal Symphony—the perfect floating home for two weeks spent exploring China from top to bottom.





Tracking Uganda's rare, endangered mountain gorillas in a protected park is a once-in-a-lifetime experience.

We've only been hiking the mist-shrouded mountains of Uganda's Bwindi Impenetrable Forest for a short time when our guide, Niyibizi Goreth, tells us our trackers have spotted the Rushegura family. A ripple of hushed excitement passes through the group — after all, this is no ordinary family. We go off-trail as Goreth — one of the park's few female rangers — slices through the foliage with a machete. That's when reality takes hold

When I woke up that morning, I was excited by the prospect of seeing a gorilla. Now, out in the bush, it seems like a crazy idea. This is no petting zoo — these gorillas live in the wild, and there are no barriers to separate them from us. But when we spot a fuzzy brown mass hanging by one arm from a tree branch, all fear dissipates: there is only a sense of awe.





Bwindi, a protected park and one of the oldest rainforests in Africa (dating back more than 25,000 years), is home to more than half of the world's remaining mountain gorillas. They can only be found here, as well as in neighboring Rwanda and the Democratic Republic of the Congo. Presently, there are nine gorilla families in the forest that have been habituated by park rangers to tolerate the presence of humans — a process that takes several years.

As we stand quietly among the trees, we see other members of the Rushegura family: One young male slides down a branchless tree like a fire pole into a scuffle with a few other males apparently over a piece of fruit. A mother carries a tiny fur-ball of a baby on her back; two others delicately groom each other. The silverback, identified as the leader of the group with a distinctive





streak of silver fur running down his back, sits alone against a tree, eyeing us.

As one of the last remaining gorilla sanctuaries in Africa, access to this region is strictly controlled. You need a permit for gorilla tracking, and groups are limited to no more than eight people per gorilla family per day. Permits are limited and must be purchased in advance; they include the services of an experienced park ranger, trackers and porters.

While you're allotted about an hour to spend with the gorillas, you don't know in advance how long it will take to find them — half an hour or half a day. That's because gorillas are always on the move in search of food, and don't sleep in

the same place for two consecutive nights. Our hour flies by and, reluctantly, we head back to park headquarters, taking a shortcut by hopping over rocks in a rushing river. Suddenly, while waiting for my turn to cross, a hulking male gorilla stalks up the path behind me.

I'm rooted to the spot as he brushes past me it's thrilling and terrifying all at the same time. I have to remind myself to breathe. Never in my life did I expect to be this close to a wild gorilla, so close I can feel his stiff fur against my pant leg. These gorillas may be habituated, but there was never any quarantee we'd see any, or that they'd let us get this close. I'm just a guest in this impenetrable forest, and I feel privileged and humbled — to be in their presence.




