### **Bellefield Great House & Gardens is one of Jamaica's oldest sugar plantations.**

This lush tropical estate sits on ten acres of land and for more than 11 generations has been part of the Kerr-Jarrett family holdings. The house was built in the 1600's as a militia outpost before becoming the official home of the Kerr-Jarrett family.

Touring the refurbished Great House you'll **recapture the essence of the period when the family spent most of their time** despite having stately homes in England. The family nurtured a genuine love for the island which they've passed down through generations and, in the spirit of philanthropy; have donated lands to benefit the less fortunate in Jamaica, including the land that the Cornwall Regional Hospital was built on.

Here, you'll **savor a delicious lunch** of jerk chicken, festival, and Jamaican dessert before continuing onto Montego Bay.

Located on the northern shore, **Montego Bay is the jewel of Jamaica's Gold Coast** and home to some of the most prestigious resorts in the Caribbean. **Spend some time touring the high points** of Montego Bay – Sam Sharpe Square, the Cage with great historic importance; Burchell Baptist and Saint James Parish Church and see life as it is lived out in the second city.

**Continue to the "Hip Strip", home of Jamaica's tourism** and pause at the "Old Fort" for a photo opportunity by the old canon which once fended off pirates. Take a peek at Doctor's Cave Beach where it's claimed the water has curative powers.

Then enjoy a short stop at Rainbow Blue Diamond Shopping Centre Shoppes of Rose Hall to **browse for duty-free items** before returning to port via the Queen's Drive.
